


Repair a girl's refuge facility to provide a physically safe environment and to enhance the care and education provided by the facility.



There will also be one stall, for each gender, designated for teachers only. This means that students will use 4 stalls. There will be a total of 2 sinks, one for each gender to be used for handwashing.

To train local women on the use of sewing machines and to sell sewn products to continue to support vocational education programs for women.



BioGas - \$3,400

To create a biogas facility for organic waste management and production of cooking fuel. A biogas digestion facility will be built to dispose of organic waste and to turn that waste into gas that will provide cooking fuel for five poor families in the village. The objective of the project is to improve waste management, protect the environment and provide low-cost sustainable energy for cooking purposes.

Study Rooms - \$3,000

Batou Hamahamet, Grande Comore

To build and equip two study rooms for student use at a local village school. The objective of the project is to increase and improve educational opportunities for young people in Comoros.



School Arts and Garden

\$5,000 - UNAGNA NA MAENDRELEYO

Mutsamudu, Anjouan

To equip an arts and dance center for after school activities in an elementary school for poor and handicapped children. To create a small fruit and vegetable garden at the school to supplement the student lunch program at the school. The school is located in a very poor area of Anjouan where many children are very poor and are cared for by extended family.



Health Center

\$5,000 - Association des Jeunes pour le développement de
Male (ACJDM)

Male, Grande Comore

To equip a village health center. The objective of the project is to provide basic health services to a remote village on Grand Comore where the population has no access to health care. The village has constructed the health center, and has arranged for volunteer nurses, midwives, and a doctor to provide professional medical care for free. The program will increase the capacity of the local community to improve the health of its population.

Solar Classrooms

\$5,000 - MOIDJIO CRCAD

Chindini, Grande Comore

To provide power for lighting a remote educational and training facility. The project will establish a solar power electrical generation capacity for training center near the marine park on the island of Moheli. The area is not electrified and training and education programs are severely restricted for lack of power and lighting. The objective of the project is to provide educational opportunities for local young people and environmental professionals.



Village Irrigation

\$5,600 - Dahari

Pemoni, Anjouan

To expand an existing communal irrigation system in the village of Pemoni. An existing irrigation system that provides water to local small fruit and vegetable plots will be expanded to encompass an additional 40-60 small plots of land. The fruit and vegetables grown support the food requirements of the local inhabitants and the excess is sold to provide the sole income for the local community. The objective of the project is to stimulate the local economy, support cooperative economic activities, and protect the environment through sustainable water use.

To rehabilitate the local school's 30 year old latrines to provide proper sanitation, protect the surrounding environment from pollution, and to fight against regular absenteeism especially among girls.



Science Lab

To purchase a variety of lab equipment and to improve the science education at the local school.

To purchase and install four solar panels and two associated deep cycle batteries to provide power to the community's multi-media library.
